

•TRAINING CENTER•

The Training Center, based on the vocational education program, offers three month and five month courses with concentration in "Policing" and with the qualifications of "Police NCO" and "Patrol".

Citizens of the Republic of Armenia, at the age of 35 years, who hold a secondary education certificate and have done compulsory military service (for male applicants), are eligible to apply.

The admission is carried out on a competitive basis. Applicants take professional compatibility and physical fitness verification tests.

Those who have successfully done the courses of the vocational education program are appointed to police entry-level positions

During the whole study, learners get the minimum monthly wage rate of the Republic of Armenia.

The Training Center also offers:

- Qualification raising courses for entry-level police officers.

- Based on the vocational education program, off-budget courses with the qualification of "Security Guard" and "Bodyguard" designed for private organizations and civilians.

- Off-budget special training courses designed for the employees of organizations carrying out special statutory duties.



Become a Lawyer on the paid basis educational program

In order to apply for the entrance, the faculty of Law of Academy of the Police Educational Complex of RA on paid basis educational program of Bachelor degree, one must have secondary level of education, as minimum.

The overall duration of the program is 4 years. Male learners of paid basis full-time educational program don't use the right of deferment, which is prescribed in the article 14.1 (a) of Law of RA on Conscription. The semi-annual study fee costs 250.000 AMD.

The applicants pass the entrance exams of two competitive subjects:

- Armenian (dictation),
- Armenian history (test).

The applicant, based on his/her will, can pass only the examination of the subject «Armenian Language», if he/she introduces the certificate (original), given by the «Assessment and Evaluation Center» SNCO, concerning to the passed joint examination on the «Armenian History» subject.

• ABOUT US •

The overall reforms made in the Armenian Police resulted in the establishment of the “Police Educational Complex of the Republic of Armenia” State Non-Commercial Organization in 2011 which comprises Academy, College and Training Center.

The Police Educational Complex provides two-level higher professional education system including Bachelor's and Master's degree programs, as well as PhD program on a part-time basis. Meanwhile it offers police intermediate-level and vocational education programs.

The Police Educational Complex offers a state-funded part-time PhD program to the commissioned police officers meeting the following eligibility criteria:

- holding higher education diploma paper or Master's degree
- having at least 2 years' work experience in police medium-level, senior-level, managerial or supreme-level positions.

There is a Department of Training and Attestation in place delivering refresher and qualification raising courses for police and other law enforcement officers as well as for police special civil service.

The teaching staff of the Police Educational Complex involves highly qualified professionals and scientists of different areas of science.

The Police Educational Complex has specialized labs and auditoriums in place equipped with state-of-the-art technical means. There are 4 gyms and a swimming pool in the Educational Complex.

The Police Educational Complex closely cooperates with a number of law enforcement educational institutions of CIS and European countries.



• ACADEMY •

Higher professional education programs offered in the Academy are realized through the Faculty of Law, Faculty of Police Troops Command, Distance Learning Faculty, Master's Program Unit.

•The Faculty of Law offers a full-time state-funded Bachelor of Laws program to future police officers as well as a full-time program for civilians on an off-budget basis. The overall duration of the program is 4 years.

Citizens of the Republic of Armenia, at the age of 35 years, who hold a secondary education certificate and have done compulsory military service (for male applicants) as well as acting police officers under the age of 35 holding a police junior-level position for no less than a year, are eligible to apply for the state-funded program.

The admission is carried out on a competitive basis. Applicants of the state-funded program take the Armenian language proficiency, professional compatibility and physical fitness verification tests.

Upon successful completion of the program, the graduates will be awarded Bachelor's degree and the graduates of the state-funded program will be awarded the rank of police lieutenant and will be appointed to police mid-level positions.

During the whole study, learners get the minimum monthly wage rate of the Republic of Armenia.

•The Faculty of Distance Learning offers a part-time state-funded Bachelor of Laws degree program to acting police officers holding police junior-level, mid-level, senior-level or managerial positions for no less than a year.

•The Master's Program Unit offers a full-time (state-funded) and part-time (off-budget and state-funded) Master of Laws programs. The overall duration of the full-time and part-time programs is 2 years and 2 years and a half respectively.

Upon completion of the program, the graduates will be awarded Master's degree in Law.

• COLLEGE •

The College offers intermediate-level education in “Policing” on a full-time basis. The overall duration of the program is 2 years.

Citizens of the Republic of Armenia, at the age of 35 years, who hold a secondary education certificate and have done compulsory military service (for male applicants) as well as acting police officers under the age of 35 holding a police junior-level position for no less than a year, are eligible to apply.



The admission is carried out on a competitive basis. Applicants take the Armenian language proficiency, professional compatibility and physical fitness verification tests.

During the whole study, learners get the minimum monthly wage rate of the Republic of Armenia.

The graduates of the College will be awarded the qualification of “Police Officer” and the rank “Police Lieutenant”. They are appointed to mid-level positions in respective police forces.
